Lion Secretary Matt has tickets for the Lockport Cave tours. All proceeds support our District Governor, Jim Muscoriel.

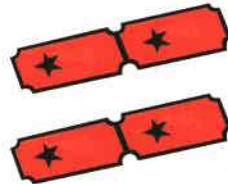
Lions in the News
